

Teachable Moments – “Give Me an RRR!”

1. **FP Rap (Pirate on Board Go RRR!)** - non-violent/friendly attitude, geography, languages
2. **Welcome Aboard** - inclusive attitude, reference to the pirate Captain William Kidd
3. **I'm the Friendly Pirate** - friendly attitude, introducing words through the repeat-after-me section (i.e. onomatopoeia, Gitchee Gumee - Native American name for Lake Superior), alliteration
4. **Aweigh and a Hey** - tongue twisters
5. **Buccaneer Bounce** - sounds and motions
6. **Pirates and Privateers** - History: short sketches of some historical pirates of the Caribbean
7. **Seven C's** - values/behaviors (Courtesy, Compassion, Courage, Cleanliness, Cleverness, Cheerfulness, and Charity) with motions, numbers, seas
8. **Pearl the Purple Pirate Princess** - colors, alliteration
9. **Twinkle Twinkle Little StaRRR** - demonstrates the concept of parody
Treasure of Smugglers' Notch - treasure hunt in the form of riddles
10. **Cranky Pirate** - shows consequence of bad behavior, reference to literary pirates
11. **Give Me an RRR!** - riddles involving words with the 'R' sound, geography
12. **Bones of Jonesy Davy** - consequences of the pirate life, what makes the unusual ghost-like noise (a saw)?
13. **FP Dance** - example of possible chores/duties on a ship, meaning of 'tote the bale'
14. **Pira-TUDE** - demonstrates a friendly, yet fun Pirate attitude
15. **Hungry Pirate** - leads to discussion of what real pirates ate
16. **Scurvy Dog and Scaredy Cat** - anthropomorphism, cultural references (Carmen Miranda, the cat's pajamas)
17. **Friend Ship** - meaning of friendship, the pun of Friend Ship and friendship
